- THRIVE SME Innovation is a collaboration between InterTradeIreland, University College Cork, University of Galway, Queens University Belfast and Technological University Dublin.
- This all-island programme brings SME leaders through a structured innovation process for engaging in ways to -
 - design, develop and plan to implement new innovative ideas for the SME
 - through in-person workshops and one-to-one sessions.
- The programme helps and supports SMEs to develop a growth plan through a targeted new product, process, service, or business model.

What is THRIVE SME Innovation?

















- Thrive is for SME leaders who are ambitious to find ways to grow their business.
- SMEs with...
 - Leaders who are ambitious to grow their business.
 - Ideally 10-100 employees.
 - Products in the market with paying customers
 - If you don't meet the above requirements but believe the programme is still relevant to your business, please contact paul.oreilly@tudublin.ie.
- Commitment to the programme
 - The programme is free to participants, but it does not support time and travel costs.
 - SME leader for six in-person days across a sixmonth period (travel required outside Dublin for 3 days).
 - Additionally, businesses can nominate 1-2 members of their company to undertake the programme alongside the SME leader.






