The final report will consist of three documents (Governance Ireland Report, an Interim BDO Report and the Mazars Report). The HEA are aware that the BDO report submitted on 21st May 2024 will be an interim report. The final BDO report will be available at the beginning of June. Governance Ireland will be scheduling meetings with key stakeholder over the next week as part of their Governing Body review. The final date for submission of the report to the HEA is 21st May 2024. A meeting of Governing Body will take place on 17th May 2024 to review the final draft report with feedback received incorporated for submission to the HEA on 21st May 2024. The HEA are currently on site and a meeting has taken place between the GBS64 Committee and the HEA. 48.B.02	 UNIVERSITY EXECUTIVE S64 UPDATE Governing Body noted the draft 'University Executive S64 Update - Draft Supporting Project Plan, (17th April 2024)' as circulated to Governing Body. Following an update by the Interim President, Governing Body noted the following: 1. The HEA met with the Interim President and Margaret Whelan (Head of Strategy and Planning) to clarify the exact requirements, content and size of the report for submission to the HEA on 21st May 2024. The HEA emphasized the following: This will be a public report and contributors should be cognisant of that. The HEA proposed a short report containing sections on the Governance Ireland Review, the Mazars Report, the BDO Report and an Action Plan The HEA outlined a reporting schedule to follow the publication of the report which will occur every two months initially for a six to twelve month period completing these review meetings after eighteen months, The HEA have proposed that after this process is completed to normalize regular meetings between TU Dublin and the HEA on the University campus. 48.B.03	 INTERIM CFO UPDATE Following a briefing by the Interim President the Governing Body noted the following: To-date the University is still awaiting approval from DPER in relation to filling this role on a permanent basis. Taking a number of factors into consideration including the retirement of the current COO, the S64 process, the normal ongoing finance function, there is an urgent need to recruit an interim CFO. The process has commenced to recruit an interim CFO which includes external recruitment agencies. The intention is to have someone in place as early as the beginning of May for a potential period of between 6-9 months. Approval by Governing Body will be required and if necessary take place electronically or at the next regular Governing Body meeting on 8th May 2024. 	NOTED
